As a HR team member, you contribute **approximately 2 hours per week** in cooperation with existing WiE members with the following tasks:

- Help Creating a Volunteer Community: This involves organizing internal events on a quarterly basis, such as get-togethers and workshops, to foster a sense of community among volunteers. These events are aimed at building relationships, sharing knowledge, and enhancing the overall experience for our WiE volunteers.
- Managing Applications and Job Postings: This task entails reviewing applications received for volunteer positions, screening candidates based on their qualifications and fit for the role. It involves assessing applicants' skills, experience, and alignment with the organization's mission and values.
- Supporting HR Coordinator with Hiring Decisions: This involves assisting the HR coordinator with making hiring decisions for volunteer positions. It includes participating in the interview process, providing input on candidate selection, and helping to onboard and offboard volunteers as needed.

- **Trustworthiness:** Ability to work with confidential data and maintain confidentiality.
- Are willing to become WiE members and engage in the organization on a long-term basis
